Overview

This pack focuses on historical discipline via a comparison of Ancient Greece and Iron Age Britain. Anthropology, archaeology and the role of the historian are examined, and substantive knowledge of both civilisations is developed. It includes a guide to note taking and an exploration of the intrapersonal skills required to undertake an 'odyssey'.

- an exploration of historical discipline and the Roman Empire

Lesson 2:

- note taking guidance focused on a live interview and gameplay - Super Mario Odyssey

Lesson 3:

- analysis and creation of a Greek amphora

Lesson 4+:

- in-depth study of Ancient Greece and Iron Age Britain
- guided writing: historical report comparing Ancient Greece and Iron Age Britain

- explore the Greek Myths
- explore the intrapersonal skills required to complete an 'odyssey'
